1.0 Purpose

2.1 Scope should be specific to the intent of the IP. WSAP IP is for those identified in positions considered TDP. The IP can discuss a company wide WSAP IP, but they should be clearly separated to reduce confusion.

 - 4.2 Random Selection (*HMIS will perform the random selection and it would be acceptable/encouraged for a subcontract to acknowledge our procedures for random selection. HMIS will make the notifications to the subcontractor and they will be responsible to notify their employee.*)
 - 4.3 Reasonable Suspicion (*For cause testing will be managed by the subcontractor, however HMIS Personnel Security will need to be engaged for those who are TDP*)

If a subcontractor wants to include their company level WSAP, they need to clarify the difference between the two programs. It is good to have a company level program, but from a requirements perspective, HMIS is concerned about TDPs.*)
